Coshocton C.A.R.E.S. will conduct a FAFSA Assistance Night to assist parents and students in filing their FAFSA information online for the 2018-2019 school year. Area college financial aid counselors will be available for assistance in completing this application.

To speed up the process on FAFSA Night, complete these items ahead of time:

- Both a parent and the student need a **FSA ID** to sign the application electronically. Obtain these at the FAFSA website: www.fafsa.ed.gov.
- Parent and student 2016 IRS 1040, 1040A or 1040EZ tax returns

Bring these items to FAFSA Night if they apply

- Student driver's license
- Balance information for parent and student savings & checking account balances.

- Selective Service Number (for boys over 18)
- A list of schools to which you want to send financial aid information

What if your tax returns are not complete?

- Bring your 2016 W-2 forms and any record of earned money for the parents and student. Also bring any of these 2016 financial records which apply to you:

- Any untaxed income records.
- Records of assistance from Jobs and Family Services or child support.

- Veteran benefits records
- Your current business & investment property information, stocks, bonds & other investment records.
- Utilize the IRS Retrieval Tool when completing your application if possible.
- This may help avoid having to produce an IRS Tax Receipt if selected for verification.
